A single perennial stream bounds the property on the southern side with an outlet to the gulf. The remainder of the coastline is all dense mangrove forest.

The remaining 71 hectares is all titled, clear of liens, taxes, all held in the personal name of the owner and seller.



Of the 71 hectares with title, count 40 of them as pastureland, 20 in recovering secondary and the remainder in primary forest. There are approximately 400 teak trees that are 15-20 years old and five or so hectares in African palm about two years old.







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
